### Things to Know About the Aim Artisan Trail

- All artisan studios and shops are open 10:00 AM –5:00 PM Saturday unless otherwise noted.
- The Arts in McNairy Artisan Trail is a biannual tour held on the third weekends of March and November but many of the artisan shops and studios welcome visitors year-round. Inquire with the individual artists about their hours of operation and pick up one of the AAT color brochures at any stop on the trail.
- Official stops are designated by signs like the one above. Look for them along major highways and at key intersections. All of the stops are on or just minutes off of Hwy 64, Hwy 45, Hwy 57 & Hwy 142.
- Please be aware that some locations are rural and may not provide restroom facilities. Public restrooms may be found at the Masonic Lodge and street festival in Adamsville and the McNairy County Museum in Selmer.
- We want you to have an enjoyable and safe stay in McNairy County, so be aware that some of the artists demonstrations may involve hazardous processes. Please do not leave small children unattended and be sure to stay in all designated visitor areas and comply with all the artisans instructions.
- Neither Arts in McNairy nor the participating artists can be responsible for your safety while on the tour, so please drive safely and observe all traffic regulations.
- Other points of interest in the McNairy County area include: Buford Pusser Home and Museum, Gibbs Oil and Gas Collectables, Shiloh Golf Course, Shiloh National Military Park (Adamsville area); McNairy County Courthouse with restored historic Pusser office and jail, Main Street USA/Whistle Stop Caf e at Henco Furniture House (Selmer area); historic Bethel Springs Presbyterian church.

1. **Hockaday Handmade Brooms** (731-645-4823) 2074 Hwy 142, Selmer - Broom making demonstrations by 4th generation broom maker Jack Martin. Also see the broom museum and purchase handmade brooms, mops & other related items.
2. **Appalachian Threads & Maiden Tennessee Gallery** (731-632-2102) 134 E. Main Street, Adamsville - Spinning, weaving studio of Constance Beck. Folk art gifts, soaps, handspun & dyed yarns. Gallery representing more than 20 local folk and fine artists.
3. **Eco-Art by Tim Pace** (731-989-2366) 82 Sherry Lynn Drive, Finger - Original sculpture crafted from everyday items recycled by metal artist Tim Pace. Demonstrations and metal sculptures for sale.
4. **Rose Creek Village** (888-849-5344) 999 Lola Whitten Rd, Rose Creek - Heritage crafts and demonstrations include: hand bound books, homemade soaps & candles, herbal teas, lathe turnings, blacksmithing, watercolor & oil painting, metal embossing and more.
5. **Firehouse Studio** (731-610-6915) 140 Warren Ave., Downtown Selmer - Handmade glass Christmas ornaments and glass lampworking demonstrations. Choose your colors and watch your glass icicles being made on the spot.
6. **2-B Pottery** (731-632-4753) 2242 Lawton Rd., Lawton. Hand thrown pottery by Sandee Barton & Rebecca Berry. Lawton studio location will be closed on Nov. 15. Visit the 2-B display and sale at the Adamsville street festival.
7. **McNairy County Museum** (731-646-0018) 114 N. 3rd Street in Downtown Selmer - Rural heritage exhibits, civil war history and more.
8. **Beulah Land Alpaca Farm** (731-645-4520) 2334 Hwy 57 West between Ramer and Eastview. See and feed the alpacas and buy handmade products fashioned from alpaca fleece.
9. **ATMT Art Gallery** (731-632-1048) 524 E. Main Street in Adamsville. Representing several local painters and other visual artists. Painting demonstrations, classes, student showing and original art work for sale. Winter/Christmas themed subjects on Nov. 15th.
10. **Ada's The Unusual County Store** (731-934-9310) 9655 Hwy 45 North in Bethel Springs - Amish bakery and country store with cookbooks, 40 varieties of cheese, meat & jerky, herbal teas, local jams, relishes, jellies, honey, sorghum, dried fruits, nuts and more.
11. **Finger Broom & Mop** (731-645-3190) 1877 Higginbottom Rd. in Selmer just off Hwy 64 West - Handmade brooms and mops by 4th generation broom maker James Robins. Antique and modern equipment displayed and demonstrated.
12. **Duncan Christmas Tree Farm** (731-645-5769) 186 Hester Rd., Selmer. Live and pre-cut Christmas trees, wreaths and holiday gift shop.
13. **Big Hill Pond State Park** (731-645-7967) Hwy 57 West - Rough camping, fishing, hiking, natural areas & Civil War history.
14. **Trail Head/Street Fair** Outdoor craft and food vendors, quilt show, Civil War demonstrators, live music, street dance and rural heritage activities. Trail head features furniture maker, Jim Jackson and others at the Masonic Lodge (behind the Methodist Church)
15. **Woodturning by Patricia Fischer** (731-934-0917) 667 Litt Wilson Rd., McNairy - Woodturning studio of Patricia Fischer. Demonstrations of contemporary and traditional lathe-turning. Handmade items for show and sale.
